





## East Indian Sann 2020 starts off with the Biggest Village Festival of the Year

Pilgrimages and Church Feasts have been a tradition of the East Indian Catholic community - the original inhabitants of Bombay. The first East Indian Sann of the year takes place at St Bonaventure Church, Erangal. The church was built in 1575 and has been an instrumental factor in promoting our rich culture and traditions. "Barai Cha Sann" or "Eragal Cha Sann" as the feast is popularly known to the East Indian community continues to be the biggest crowd puller as East Indians from more than 100 gaothans gather to venerate St. Bonaventure. Barai cha Sann, simply translated means 12 days after Christmas and marks the baptism of our Lord Jesus Christ.

This annual celebration begins with 9 day novenas in English & Marathi and concludes on the second Sunday of January. On the feast day, the wide seashore in front of the church is transformed into a huge fair with entertainment like giant wheel, merry-go-rounds, horse rides and various other games like tossing the ring, shooting the balloons and plenty of toys to enthrall both the young and old.

This feast has unique variety of stalls selling local produce like shingara, kasara, tarle and sukelis and if you have a wedding in the family don't forget to buy the Ghumat.

In the olden days many people used to travel by reklas and tongas and even today some try to keep the tradition alive. To celebrate Barai Cha Sann, patrons venture out to the ancient church in buses filled with large number of devotees to pay their respect to their beloved saint and to witness the grand gala. The first stop is the church where you can attend the Holy mass as they are celebrated hourly till noon. After venerating St. Bonaventure, the beach is the next stop so that all can enjoy the fair before you can go to relax at the various adjoining wadis which are transformed into mini gaothans. When you walk through these wadis you can see chullas fired up and the aroma of mutton curry and mula/arkhol wafts through. The various wadis come alive as festival celebrations are in full swing with the sound of music and dancing accompanied by the ghumat and echoing voices of Sukhala. And as the sun sets and people leave for their respective Gaothans, the memories of singing, dancing and merriment linger in the air eagerly awaiting the next year.

Barai Cha Sann is organised by the Madh Gaothan parishoners and is widely celebrated across Madh gaothan. The houses in the gaothan extend their festive season and don't take off their Christmas decorations until Barai feast is over. Guests arrive for the weekend, enjoy scrumptious East Indian spread of chicken moile, mutton khudi, vindaloo and fugias and many more traditional dishes and enjoy Barai cha Sann wholeheartedly.

After a very successful but tiring day, the parishoners offer a special Thanksgiving mass on Monday and enjoy the Sheela Sann along with their relatives and friends.
