



The Migrants took over our basic rights to do business on our Native Land. Be it Newspaper, Milk, Vegetables, fruits, food and anything whatsoever they occupied our streets and corners. Migrants settled and saw opportunities for businesses and earned in lakhs while the salaried earned in thousands.

Our community members need to go back to our roots and start Businesses. Hardwork and Dedication will be the basic requirement to succeed with a little bit of patience. Our business community will have to focus on Competitive rates and good quality. As time goes by our businesses will grow bigger and spread out into branches or franchisees.

Time to give community businesses a boost with an East Indian Touch. Let's ensure we occupy the prominent spots at Gaothans and it's vicinity. It's encouraging now to see our community members including youngsters getting into small businesses selling fresh fish, dry fish, vegetables, fruits and food. This is just a start and if we continue with this we may surely see a encouraging number of new businesses owned by our community.

We at MGP would love to support all those who want to start their businesses. Our dream of the East Indian Business Network (EIBN) may very well come true in the current situation. This is a God sent opportunity for us Natives to reclaim what was rightfully ours. Also a request to all locals to support our community businesses.
