Churches all across Bombay Diocese are dedicated to various Saints and it's time now to dedicate a religious structure to our Patron and Native Saint Gonsalo Garcia. Every East Indian should be proud of our Saint who was born in Vasai and died in Nagasaki, Japan. There are Churches dedicated internationally too to St.Gonsalo Garcia and we have 4 churches in Vasai. A need to have a religious structure in Bombay Diocese was felt very strongly, and so Mobai Gaothan Panchayat decided to take forward this project to built a Chapel.

istory and heritage will be the themes under which we plan to build this chapel. Giving the chapel a relevance to the place of his birth in Gass, Vasai and also his place of martyrdom in Nagasaki, Japan, is what we are planning on. The important happenings in the lives of our Patron Saint will be compiled, and ways to connect with the chapel will be drawn. Depending on the feasibility, we plan to build the chapel structure on a boat to connect our Saint History, going back to when he set sail on a boat from India to Japan. The chapel structure may have a linkage to the church structure in Nagasaki dedicated to the 26 Martyrs or the Gass church in Vasai. The facade of the boat structure may have the images of the 26 Martyrs linked to the Nagasaki Museum dedicated to our Saint amd his companions.

wareness of the Chapel project is being drawn by a dedicated team from various backgrounds. In a few weeks, the team will be assigned their jobs and start work actively. The fund generation will be the major challenge as this project may cost around 1 crore if we have to purchase the land. The teams will brainstorm on various ways to generate support for the biggest MGP project. The first step through appeal has been finalised already and will be distributed across Mumbai. East Indians abroad will also be approached to help this community mega project. The finance team is drafting its 1st phase of plans for the Chapel Finance Management.

romotion of our Saint will also be one of our major objectives. St. Gonsalo Garcia has a rich history unknown to so many and ways to promote them are being finalized. We will soon approach the publishers of the book on St. Gonsalo Garcia for a reprint to be distributed to all donors. Special merchandises are being created to present memorabilia to those who support this project in the form of fridge magnets, key chains and more. Miniature statues to be placed at home altars are also being planned.

nriching our religious devotions to our native devotions are also on plan for St. Gonsalo Garcia, as well as, Mount Mary. Special hymns will be written by experts with music by the most talented in our community. Prayers in the East Indian Dialect will also be created with special East Indian Marathi Holy Masses at regular intervals. The community members will be requested to place large Statues at Gaothan Holy Crosses for veneration of our Saint. The St. Gonsalo Garcia Day announcement by MGP few years back seems to be slowly succeeding with many websites also mentioning St. Gonsalo Garcia as the Patron Saint of the East Indians.

ove for our Patron Saint was missing and gradually vanishing, and reviving this will be our top priority and on the agenda. MGP has taken upon itself one of the biggest challenges through this project and it's success is totally dependent on our community at large. We appeal to all in our Community for their prayers and support. Let's build the first religious structure dedicated to our Native and Patron Saint in Bombay Diocese. This could very well be our first step towards a self dependent and dedicated Community working towards Development, Upliftment and Empowerment. Hands that have a strong passion and desire to serve our Community are more than welcome to join our Vibrant Chapel Team. Together, let's make this dream a reality.


