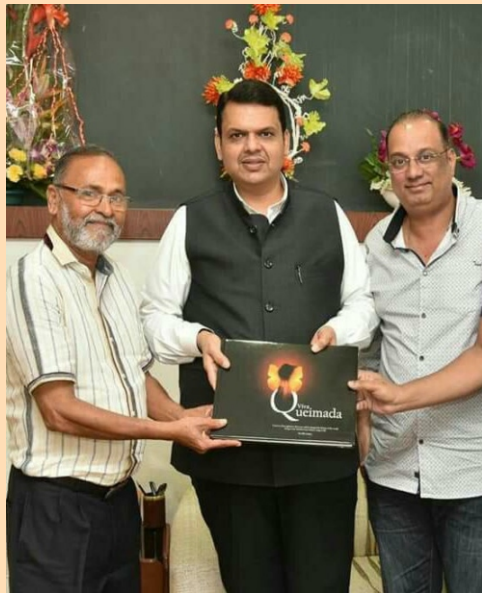

Bombays Natives, the East Indians to pay their respects to Community freedom fighter

KAKA BAPTISTA JAYANTHI – MGP Demands sports facility as Indigenous People

The East Indian Community celebrates 154th Birth Anniversary on March 17th

Mobai Gaothan Panchayat(MGP) in its efforts to create awareness of Bombay Natives, the East Indian Community had declared in 2013 that March 17th every year will be observed as Kaka Baptista Jayanthi. Joseph “Kaka” Baptista is a freedom fighter who was a close associate of Lokmanya Tilak during India's freedom struggle. Kaka Baptista was born on March 17, 1864 at Matharpacady, Mazagaon. His father, John Baptista hailed from Uttan, near Bassein. This year the community will celebrate the 154th Birth Anniversary.

To commemorate this special Day for the East Indian Community, MGP plan is as follows

Uttan -The local east indian community along with MGP representatives – Walter Murzello and Alphi Dsouza paid their respects at the Bust of Kaka Baptista, Uttan. MGP had renovated the shed, canopy and painted the place a couple of years ago.

As the East Community celebrates the 154th Birth Anniversary this year the community has now taken upon itself to revive its culture, tradition and raise their voices against the injustice towards the community. MGP will communicate to the BJP government in Maharashtra to give due importance and benefits to the sons of soil community of Bombay, Thane, Raigad and Vasai. Special appreciation to the community freedom fighter, Kaka Baptista will also be demanded.

A couple of years ago, MGP has decided to demand for a sports facility for the community dedicated to the community leader. Its surprising that the Indigenous people of Bombay, the East Indian Community does not have a single sports facility of the community even though a majority of the lands owned were taken away under the disguise of development. Many of these have been allotted to various trusts, NGO's and various organizations but nothing has been granted to the East Indian Community. MGP will make a fresh demand along with their other demands presented every year. The Sports facility will be named Kaka Baptista Sports Complex catering to the sons-of-soil community.

Some of the highlights about Kaka Baptista are as follows:-

- *Kaka Baptista coined the phrase”Swaraj is my Birth Right” which was later made popular by Tilak
- *Kaka Baptista was the First Mayor of Bombay in the year 1925-1926
- *He worked with BMC for 17 years from the year 1901
- *The Mazagaon Gardens is named after him and was recently renovated
- *He assisted Tilak by launching the Sarvajanik Ganpati(public Ganpati celebrations)
- *He was a legal advisor to Lokmanya Tilak.
- *Played an active role in the Home Rule Movement along with Lokmanya Tilak and Annie Besant.
- *As an Advocate in the High Court , he defended Veer Sarvarkar and demanded an open trial on the basis of fundamental rights.

Due to his valuable contribution to the city and India's freedom struggle, MGP has demanded the following to commemorate his 154th Birth Anniversary

- *The Bandra- Worli Sealink to be named after Kaka Baptista
- *Bandra Terminus to be named after Kaka Baptista
- *Special sports facility for the sons-of-soil community
- *A special Community fund to be started for the natives, to support the community for Education, Medical and other needs.
- *Land to be allotted for East Indian Bhavan to have an auditorium/hall in memory of Kaka Baptista.
- *Kaka Baptista to be recognised by the Maharashtra Government for his valuable contribution to the city and country and various projects to be named after him
- *March 17th to be recognised as Kaka Baptista Jayanthi by the Maharashtra State Government and also a special commemoration by the BMC.
- *An East Indian to be directly chosen as a Corporator by the community members and associations to represent in the BMC House

East Indian Easter

About 46 days of Lent, each and everyone has a different way of celebrating Easter and abstaining during Lent. My earliest memories of Lent go back to when I was a little girl, growing up in a typical East Indian Gaothan; starting with pancakes and prayers, ending with Vindaloo and music, the church being just 5 mins away from home, so one can picture how it is. Listening to the church bells ring, listening to the Papiyas late at night and staying put in the house with strict warnings not to look out, those hymns that touch the soul and give you goose bumps every time you hear them making you feel a piercing pain.

My grandmother was very strict about Lenten time, we obviously abstained from meats but we also had to abstain from too much entertainment like TV time and music which worked out in our favour because it is always exams during Lent. We had to attend Stations of the cross which was conducted for children on every Thursday, and the Pass which was in Marathi every Sunday evening at 5 pm. Being a child and sitting through sermons knowing that you have to go back home and study was not the best feeling but it had to be done. The last Sunday in Lent being Palm Sunday and we had an enactment of Veronica during the Pass service, so we knew that Easter is at hand, the Holy week was really holy with prayers and watching religious channels if any. Eating simple food and praying daily. Our street would start smelling of East Indian delicacies right from Maundy Thursday, Vindaloo and Easter eggs aromas from every home, we typically made vindaloo, sorpotel, roast chicken with stuffing at the side, Stew, Chicken Moile, (my mouth salivating as I am typing this), hand breads, Fruit cake, phugias. All this is about my East Indian Easter as a child and Spinster.

I am fortunate to get married into an East Indian Family and I moved into another Gaothan, so all my Lenten and Easter memories revived with a few changes here and there but here too I had a grand mother who was very particular about prayers, a family who abstained from meats and any kind of non veg and alcohol, all my childhood memories refreshed. Easter is even more grander here, I start the Easter eggs and Cake preparations as the Holy week begins, I am blessed to have a mother (in Law) who is more a friend and mentor to me, she has taught me so many East Indian delicacies to precision that I look forward to abstaining during Lent just to enjoy all the preparations for Easter to the fullest. This year we prepared Easter Eggs, Marble Chocolate cake, East Indian Pork sausages, Pork Sorpotel, Stuffed Chicken (8 to be precise), Potato chops, Phugias (well I can feel my bones ache while I write this). All this wonderful food and the best family to share with. Easter makes me Nostalgic brings me my childhood and at the same time makes me feel so blessed and fortunate to be able to give others a beautiful feast.

So all in all, An East Indian Easter is all about our Faith, Food, Family and Fun. I hope you all had a fun filled Easter and a blessed Lenten season, I just shared my experience, hoping to take you all back to your earliest memories of Easter.

Regan has been instrumental in naming a road with the East Indian theme in May 2016 and another 2 roads will be named soon at Kanjur Gaothan.

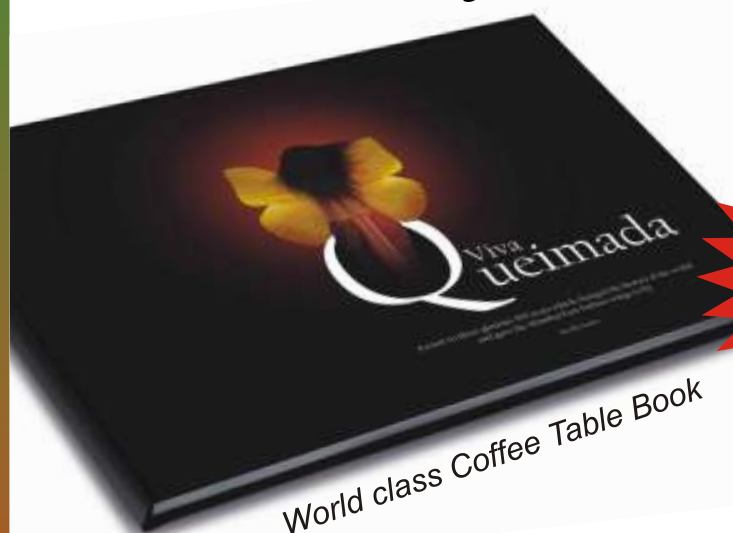
