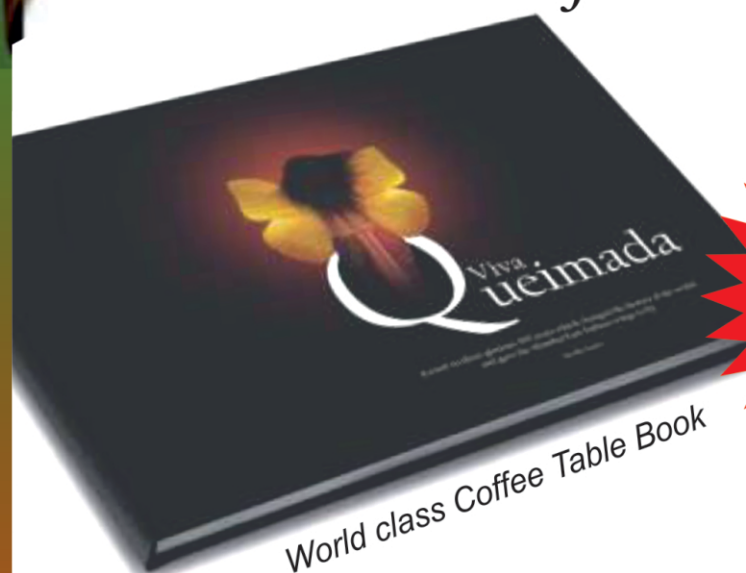

LETRI- THE EAST INDIAN HERITAGE THEME OF THE MONTH

Talk of East Indian sweets and not mentioning Letri would not be justified. Be it a feast or wedding, Letri is a staple. And we bet you can never stop at one bite.

Although a simple delicacy without anything fancy, Letri has the perfect blend of ingredients that give a burst of taste. The fresh and juicy grated coconut and the melt-in-the-mouth, sweet jaggery perfectly complement the bland yet rich rice noodles. As all these ingredients come together creating a perfect harmony in the mouth, who can resist a second bite?!

WHAT IS LETRI?

Letri is a delicacy made of rice noodles, which are made on a letri ghora. Small balls made of rice flour are boiled and stacked up a letri ghora. Different food color is also added to make it look pleasing. Pressure is applied using a rotating disk, to get strings of rice flour.

Although it sounds simple, it is quite a tedious process. All of the procedure needs to be done the rice flour dough balls are still boiling hot to get the perfect letri noodles. Thus making letri always requires an additional set of hands for assistance.

These noodles are then layered on a big plate or traditionally, a paraat, with freshly grated coconut and roughly chopped jaggery pieces or jaggery powder, nowadays. Like other dishes, the three major ingredients of letri, rice noodles, jaggery, and coconut are not cooked together. Hence all three retain their individual tastes and textures while combining to give the perfect taste.

In olden days, 'Letri Ghoras' were originally made of wood. However, now they are available in copper or stainless steel. Letri is served at joyous occasions such as weddings and feasts, especially Introze.

AAPLAA GAAV! AAPLAA SANN!

East Indians never miss an opportunity to feast and celebrate. Thus, church and gaothan feasts have always been close to the East Indian community. People of the community come together to celebrate and have fun.

In the coming month, between February 15 to March 15, 2024, we do not have any feasts that East Indians celebrate, however, the period marks the beginning of lent or korezma.

14TH FEBRUARY - KOREZMA

This year Korezma starts on February 14, 2024, and will end on March 30, 2024. It begins with 'Rakhecha Budhwar' or Ash Wednesday which falls on February 14. During the 40 days or korezma, Catholics fast, repent, and give alms as they prepare for the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus.

Korezma, the period of 40 days, has multiple other religious events such as Ramacha Paas (Palm Sunday), Khursachi Vaat (Way of the cross), Papiyas and others.

The Carnival of the Maharashtra People - East Indian Samaj

- *Like Carnival is celebrated across the world before Ash Wednesday, in East Indian Gaothans its called Introze
- *Celebrations generally starts from the Saturday before Ash Wednesday
- *The celebration used to happen community wise, referred as Gothra and some Gaothans call it Goth.
- *The highlight of the celebration is the community dinner celebrated from Fat Sunday to Package Tuesday
- *This is a festivity before the season lent when many begin 40 days of fasting and abstinence
- *The preparation starts on the morning of the day the celebration is planned
- *On this day only the men folk do all the work and cooking the only dish, mutton khuddi
- *Depending on the size of the Gothra, male goats were slaughtered and a special Introze Khuddi Masala was prepared
- *The Village square was cleaned and made ready for the evening festivities
- *An hour before the Introze dinner, the women dressed in their best would go around the village to the houses where the new bride or recently married couple reside
- *They would have fund and even have chownis of the home brewed drink
- *The would deck the new bride with a gajra of mogra flowers and go the the next house of a newlywed couple and finally proceed to the village square
- *Each family member carried their own plate and bread
- *The people say on mats and were served the mutton khuddi by men
- *After having their dinner, they filed the played with one for serving of mutton khuddi to be taken home and eaten the next day, when the taste of the mutton khuddi be much better
- *Those celebrating on Tuesday had to finish the celebration by 12 midnight as the next day was Ash Wednesday, a day of abstinence
- *This custom still continues in most of the Gaothans
- *Various East Indian Gaothans celebrate this traditional festival in different ways
- *In some. gaothans, local groups organise get together with food, music and fun
- *In some Gaothans, residents bring their own meals and celebrate together like potluck
- *Some have brass bands and special music performances

Keeping culture and traditions alive without making too many changes is the need of today's times. We should not deflect from the traditional celebrations and its relevance. MGP has drafted guidelines for Introze as per traditions and we appeal to each community to follow the same. Introze which is the East Indian Carnival celebration was a great way to get the Village people together as one big family. If the Gaothan is United it can create wonders and give the system a tough time its decisions are made against the interests of the local community.

House to house visits should be initiated for all newly weds, to welcome them to join the Introze Procession. In this way we are creating a feeling of inclusiveness for the newly wed couple as members of the village family. In East Indian customs the newly weds get a lot of respect at villages festivals like San Jao which is also called Jaavaycha Sann and also the Introze festival. The newly wed couple is also given importance during Catholic celebrations like Christmas, Easter and the parish feast. Taking the newly wed couple in procession with the satir accompanied by the brass band is a perfect way to welcome them to the Village family.

Unique themes can make the Introze celebration more impactful without forgetting the East Indian Community connect. The Lugra theme seems to get very popular at all community celebrations which is surely a great sign. Creating a fusion of a theme with the East Indian connect is an ideal combination to ensure our culture revival is on the right path. As far as possible we should stick to the village based celebration organised by the local community groups or by the goth(family). A mega celebration by bigger groups could be organised a week prior but should be limited to just a few. The last week should be reserved for the local gaothan celebrations.

Dance and Music plays an important role in the celebrations. We need to ensure that all music or a majority of it should be in the East Indian dialect. The brass band could be organised to give the celebration a perfect East Indian touch. Well known performers from the community could be invited but we need to also give importance to singers from our own Gaothan. A ghumat session should be slotted ideally after the sound time restrictions are over. A procession around the village with the brass band, fancy dress and people dancing should be included

Dinner should be the spotlight of the event. Only East Indian food specialty to be served. As per traditions the Mutton Khuddi was the main dish and the same should be included for sure. It possible the men should cook for the day but surely make all the necessary arrangements and decorations. Additionally, the men should serve the refreshments and dinner for all the local people. A great way it give our community women rest and also give an opportunity for them to celebrate and have fun. An East Indian dessert could be arranged too.

Introze needs to grow each year in every East Indian Community Village, in a Gaothan or Goth(family level). MGP had launched its Revival Project last year titled, EIntroze 2025 wherein we plan to have around 50 Introze Celebrations in the traditional East Indian way. Our team has been informed to encourage more such festivities with an aim to recall festive memories of our ancestors. We are also looking at various other initiatives to help promote our traditional carnival celebrations, Introze. MGP appeals to all community members to do their bit in their respective villages by organising Introze and making it much bigger each passing year.

PAN CAKES

Ingredient

½ Kg Refined Flour
4½ Cup Milk
1 Tsp Salt
4 Eggs
Mix the batter well and keep aside.
Colours as per your choice.

Fillings

2 Coconuts Grated
¼ Cup Cashews / Raisins
100 Gms Mawa
1 Tsp Vanilla or Rose Essence
½ Cup Rose Water
1¼ Cup Sugar

Method

Take a vessel and add the above grated coconut, sugar rose water and cook till done. Once coconut is cooked add the dry fruits, essence, stir well.

Heat the non stick pan add little oil and wipe it out with a tissue paper. Take spoonful of batter make a pancake and at the same time put the filling and roll it as shown in the pic first fold from both ends and then roll. Repeat this process till you are done with the entire batter.
