## Papiyas - Special Prayers and Hymns at Lenten time

Bhavando, utha tumche neezemanche, deemi ghala, lazaar kara, ek Amche Bapala......

- \*Papiya is a Marathi word which means Penitents
- \*Papiyas or Devaats as they are called, are a group of devout christians who move about from cross to cross at the dead of night, chanting prayers and imploring Christians to wake up from their sleep, get down on their knees and pray and ask for God's forgiveness
- \*These groups become active from the Sunday night before Palm Sunday and their activity culminates in a crescendo on Maundy Thursday
- \*Papiyas organize themselves into groups of 10 to 20 persons or more and start with visiting various Gaothans during Lenten time
- They shroud themselves in black or blue or brown tunics with a hood so they cannot be easily recognized\*
- \*Their lamentable chants in tones similar to Gregorian chants are in East Indian dialect
- \*Listening to their mournful chants can be a hair raising experience and can send shivers down ones spines, especially when one hears them at the dead of night.
- \*Tradition has it that Papiyas from one village would visit the neighbouring village and vice versa, No two groups could come face with each other.
- \*If both groups had the occasion to travel and would cross paths, then the group that spotted the passing group would hide behind the bunds (baands) of the field till the other group passed by
- \*People of the neighbourhood would keep a kettle of hot tea at the foot of the cross for the Papiyas. Papiyas are representative of the apostles Peter, James and John who accompanied Jesus to the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus prayed and during the 'Agony' on the Mount of Olives.

These three dedicated gentleman founded the Mobai Gaothan Panchayat and immersed themselves the study of the history of the East Indian community encompassing a staggering number of events including the customs the dress codes for every occasion the recipes, East Indian music and many other facets of the community the special events to be celebrated annually and very importantly the East Indian Marathi Dialect language even having printed a Marathi/English dictionary! They have set up and inaugurated many a festival from football to music to food festivals, our East India Anthem Kaka Baptista museum East Indian bazaars, press releases on various subjects, honouring our Patron Saint Gonsalo Garcia ,prominent East Indians, interactions with Diocese of Bombay and MLA's in our areas, Government Officials , construction of Garcia Chapel, Sarpanchs in every area of East Indian Gaothans, annual calendars beautiful crafted with information of various types and recipes, E I clothes fashions, etc. "Gaothan Voice" a monthly bulletin for the Community and there is very much more that can be written and will be in coming future

## Trindaz/Trindat Cha Sann/Dongracha Sann

The Feast of the Holy Trinity Church in Powai is celebrated on the last Sunday of May. This is an East Indian Village Festival which still attracts thousands of East Indians every year.

\*The Church is located on a hill and a new Church has been built behind which lies the ruins of the old church.

\*Decades ago our community travelled to this Church on Gaaras(Bullock Carts) and Reklas(Horse carts).

\*Holy Trinity Church is the 3rd Oldest Church in Bombay diocese. The Jesuits founded the Holy Trinity Church in the Valley of Vihar in 1550, but the valley was so malarious that they moved to the hillock in 1557

\*This hilltop church was operational right up to 1737, until the Maratha conquest damaged it severely

\*Legend has it that the original Church of the Most Holy Trinity today lies submerged under Vihar Lake, where the top is sometimes visible when the water level goes down. Locals also believe that a statue of Mother Mary with Infant Jesus and a cross was found in the Vihar lake bed and it now rests inside the Condita church in Marol

\*Incidentally Powai includes Gaothans - Tirandaj, Koprikund, Saki, Paspoli and Tungave

\*The Creado family from Juhu Gaothans for decades has been celebrating their Cross feast at the Holy Cross inside the church premises on the eve of the Church feast

\*Until some years ago they took a bus load of Juhukars for the Cross feast and then used to stay overnight by settling themselves in the church compound to celebrate the feast the next day.

We appeal to our community to celebrate this festival and ensure this Village Festival is not forgotten by our future generations.

As per updates received, there are 4 Holy mass services this year and only one of them is in Marathi. A Communication will be sent to the Church and the Archdiocese to ensure the traditional feast is revived and all Holy Masses are only in our Maharashtra state language, Marathi, the Feast mass to be in Marathi only and one mass could be in English.

riginal Inhabitants or Bhumiputra or Indigenous People status needs to be recognised and acknowledged. Our very own Existence and Identity is being questioned and challenged at various forums. The majority or the elite wins is the rule of the game today. We as a community need to change this false narrative. It's we as Indigenous People who existed here before the migrants settled and it's therefore our foundation and welcoming nature which has helped many to settle in this great city. The system also many a times does not recognise our identity as the Bhumiputra Samaj of Mumbai Metropolitan Region. We need to voice out this across all forums till we are heard and we should never ever lose out on this mission.

Traditions & Culture are the key aspects of our Community. These practices defines us as Mumbai's Indigenous People. While the community traditions and culture is being promoted as sees an increase in the intersection levels, we need to keep up with this rising momentum.
