



Empowering the Next Generation - My Passion for Establishing a Skilling College at Dharavi Beth

In 2018, when I had the privilege of receiving the St. Gonsalo Garcia Award, I had the opportunity to present my vision for Dharavi Island to an engaged audience. 

For centuries the Gaothan residents, the original inhabitants of Mobai lived in peace until the time strangers across India entered our precious city in the last decades. They came and stayed on rent, purchased properties for a pittance and the authorities grabbed land under the disguise of infrastructure development. And we all stayed quiet due to our peace-loving nature. Mobai was later called Bombay by the Portuguese and the British rulers and about a decade ago we call this lovely city Mumbai due to our beloved politicians.

Today our very own Gaothan residents, the Sons of Soil are ill-treated as if we are strangers in our self-owned city. We welcomed all strangers irrespective of caste, creed or religion and a sizeable number of these strangers have now pushed us aside with their growing greed. Our tenants have more rights than we the landlords and so get a better share during redevelopment projects. The properties purchased for a pittance by cheating or forgery has now been sold for huge unimaginable sums. Finally, the authorities who grabbed our lands under the disguise of infrastructure have restructured their plans giving way to five star hotels, malls and other development projects. Mobai , the city of Seven Islands has now combined into a Single Concrete Island.

NOTHING....And we still stayed quiet. For how long can we stay in ignorance and silence. Wake up, my dear people before whatever you have is taken away. The slums which just came up a couple of years ago have been allotted flats, the marshy land have been covered making way for development schemes. The authorities have gone about blindly giving away additional FSI to all structures that exist.... except the Gaothans. The Gaothan fault remains that we stayed quiet and so we don't deserve FSI. We have to run from pillar to post for repair permissions as if we are all tenants...

A group of like-minded Gaothan residents have now got up to raise their Voices under the banner of Gaothan Voice, a monthly bulletin launched in March 2009. The Gaothan Voice shared a plan to start the Gaothan Panchayat, tried this initiative some months ago at Juhu and now plans to make this an All-Mobai initiative. The Mobai Gaothan Panchayat will be launched by March end and will promote Civic and Social initiatives in our Gaothans. The Mobai Gaothan Panchayat will be an informal body that will demand the basic rights for the Gaothan people.

Gaothan Voice welcomes each one of you to be a part of the Gaothan Revolution under the banner of Mobai Gaothan Panchayat, CHANGE begins with ME. Be the Change you want to see by actively participating in our activities. Together lets raise our Voices against the injustice against our Community.




