For the first time ever : A Stall selling East Indian themed books, umbrella and merchandise

*We at MGP have been trying for a Bandra Fair stall for almost a decade as there were no stalls visible of the Indigenous People at the Mount Mary steps

*This year as stall bookings went online a MGP member applied and was allotted a stall of 5ft by 3ft for Rs.10,276/- and a refundable deposit of Rs.4355/-

*A few MGP members contributed towards the stall hire charges as we wanted an East Indian Indigenous People stall visible at the Bandra Fair

*Our Stall no.77 was situated after the last Mount Mary steps selling books, Lugas, umbrellas & merchandise

*We had also hired a stall manager due to unavailability of our members on working days

*Our plans was not to cover the total costs of the stall and make a profit but the intention was to showcase East Indians Existence & Identity at the Bandra Fair

*Our continuous requests for more focus on devotion seems to have taken shape this year

*While we have entered the Bandra Fair through the very last steps, we will climb step by step each year to reach the greater heights of the Mount

*We may have a special crowd funding drive next year for East Indian Baazaar Network Stalls to set up their business on the Mount Mary Steps

*With Mount Mary's blessings we managed to cover the cost of the stall and also make a small excess to fund our community projects

MGP took one big step at this year's Bandra Fair keeping in mind its aim for Creating & Promoting East Indian Existence, Identity, Culture and Tradition.

*** MGP CONGRATULATES MOUNT MARY CHURCH FOR A WELL ORGANISED BANDRA FAIR AND THE STALL ALLOTMENT PROCESS CHANGE ***

*Mobai Gaothan Panchayat (MGP) representing the Indigenous People of Mumbai - Koli, Aagri, Bhandari and Kulbi feel the Church management did a great job by changing the stall allotment process

*Online process was a welcome change from a partial process earlier

*It's also encouraging that the Rector - Fr Vernon Aguiar and Vice Rector - Fr Sunder Albuquerque have focused on Devotion and lesser on the commercialised factor

*The opening of the exhibition centre is one of the best initiatives of Mount Mary Basilica

*Alloting the immediate prominent stalls to Churches and religious articles was also a very good move

*The washrooms have been nicely renovated and the stalls quality are much better and presentable

*The Stalls rates may need to be reworked and made lesser but keeping the cost of stalls and other facilities in mind

*The stall allotment process may need to be tweaked a bit and MGP Policy & Strategy team will suggest to the Mount Mary Church management on the same

*The new process will take time to be acknowledged and hence a bit of teething issues which is obvious in every new process but this is surely a welcome move

*MGP continues to request for around 20 stalls for Indigenous People - East Indians & Kolis at special affordable prices keeping the stall installation costs in mind

*Some older stalls owners are miscommunicating by calling themselves as natives and Traditional stall owners when actually only Indigenous People of Mumbai (Kolis & East Indians) have the right to call themselves as natives, the initiators of the Bandra feast tradition and the founders of the Bandra Fair.

MGP representing the Bhumiputra East Indian Samaj thanks and appreciates the Mount Mary Church management for this first big step with focus more on Devotion and lesser on commercialisation this year. While we have many other requests, this is surely one big step to make the Bandra Fair better organised as per the suggestions of the Indigenous People of Mumbai

Request! Remind! ReAct! - Mission Agera

Archdiocesan Support is one of the important aspects in celebration of one of the biggest East Indian festivals of the year, Agera. Cardinal Oswald Gracias has been kind enough to share Agera greeting videos on our request year on year. We have also requested Archbishop Felix Machado for his support in the Vasai Diocese and he was prompt to have an article on Maharashtra Indigenous People's Agera in their Diocesan magazine, Suvarta. Our focus now turns towards the Vasai Diocese region to promote Agera traditions and celebrations. The parish support across East Indian Villages of Maharashtra has been mixed and we are trying to connect across our network to get updates and plan way forward accordingly. The upward trend in celebrations is on the rise in a majority of villages but some seem to be facing issues due to lack of clergy support and local participation.

Gaothan Base for celebrations should be our biggest focus and we should aim for lesser dependency on parish council and clergy. There has been some encouraging success stories and at the same time some saddening ones too. The major reason has been the parish council or clergy or both. Parish councils with a majority of migrant representatives have been conveniently voting against our indigenous people religious traditions and the hierarchy has been quite on our demand to have an East Indian representative appointed in all parish councils. Parish Council have no right to decide on indigenous people religious traditions and the hierarchy has to release an Indigenous People Policy in this regard. It's time our local activists and groups focus on celebrations with a base from our Gaothans. Lets make the local church dependent on our Gaothans and it should not be the other way round.

Existence and identity should be our biggest objective across the community. In the last few decades our community has seen a dip in its visibility and activity but the last few years have been encouraging. In parishes we begin to hear of how the very existence of our community is being questioned and some religious heads have sidelined our East Indian identity. Even the Government bodies and political leaders don't recognise our indigenous people existence and identity. Creating awareness and visibility of our existence and identity should be one of our leading initiatives. Emphasising and observing all our religious traditions should be ensured across parishes.

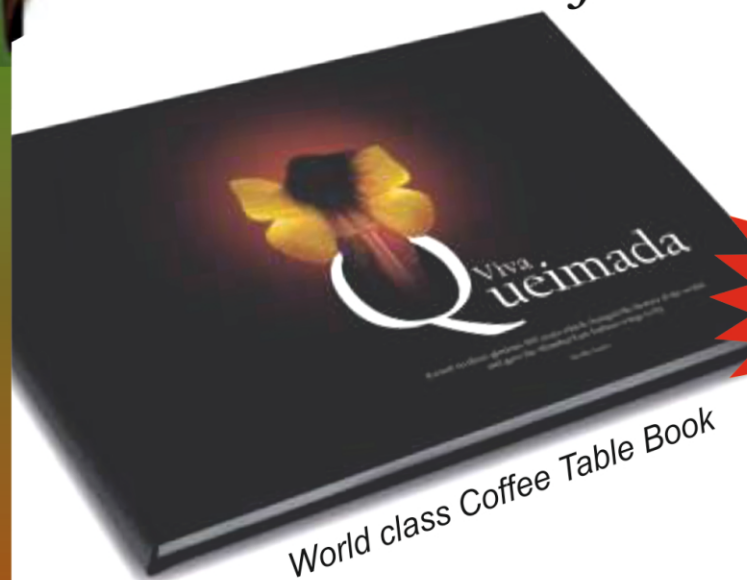
Revival opportunity for celebrating Agera is bountiful across Villages. With this also comes the promotion of our state language, Marathi and the East Indian dialect. Community members should stay connected with their relatives and friends across the state to ensure Agera is celebrated and revived across the length and breadth of East Indian Villages in Maharashtra. The Agera special mass should be in Marathi or East Indian and bilingual could be allowed basis approval by local East Indian activists and groups. All masses for Agera in English should compulsorily sing an East Indian or Marathi hymn. Agera celebration at Vasai Diocese has been low key and MGP plans to connect with our network to get this activated and revived in a bigger way.

Agera Agera Agera, and no Thanksgiving day or joint community harvest festival. Some parish clergy heads and parish councils have been trying to drive the anti-Agera agenda which needs to be stopped with immediate effect. This Indigenous People festival should be referred only as Agera and not Thanksgiving day. Some parishes have been giving the "Agera" term a backseat to fulfil their agendas hence we need to be alert and speak up now before it's too late. Request, Remind and ReAct is our action plan for MGPs Mission Agera. We will first Request the clergy heads and parish councils, then Remind them about the same and if we don't get a positive response we will ReAct the East Indian Way. Mission Agera is all about ensuring religious traditions are followed and cultural celebrations are organised besides ensuring the services are in our State language Marathi or the native East Indian dialect. Lets ensure Mission Agera is accomplished and we at MGP are available for any support you may need on the parish or diocesan level.
