

To bring together and unite the East Indian community as one family.



Wood carver family, ACP, educationist are East Indian newsmakers

Entrepreneurs, religious leaders, cultural icons felicitated by Mobai Gaonthan Panchayat at their 15th awards ceremony

A family of wood carvers from Vasai, the Sequeira Brothers, whose sacred iconography forms an integral part of worship in many Marathi churches and shrines and religious institutions abroad, are the 'East Indian NewMakers of the Year'. The family, which began the tradition in the 1920s, was also honoured for their work in the restoration of Mount Mary Basilica at the St. Andrew's Church in Bandra.



The awards, given by the Mobai Gaonthan Panchayat, recognise religious leaders, educationists, and cultural icons from the East Indian community. The ceremony was held recently at St. Andrew's Auditorium in Bandra. The honours also recognised non-East Indians whose work impacted a community that is counted among the city's east side residents.

Sylvester D'Souza, the chairman, founder, and managing trustee of St. Lawrence

Educational and Charitable Trust, was presented the East Indian of the Year 2025 award. The trust runs schools that have shaped generations into

responsible citizens. D'Souza is also the president of the East Indian Peoples' Association, which runs schools that have shaped generations into

Estate, Thane, and also runs cooperative cell structures.

The other honourees included the Basen Catholic Cooperative Bank, founded in 1988 by Mamta Lawrence D'Souza for her work that led to a life imprisonment conviction in a case of assault on a child registered at Kamathe (Nar Mumbai) police station.

The evening featured a live performance by New Boys Band from Uttan and a special East Indian lunch.

MGP & EAST INDIAN COMMUNITY - STAYS COMMITTED TO SUPPORT DIOCESE IN TIMES OF NEED



Flow of events:

- In July 2025, MGP sent a communication for review and change in the process of admissions to ensure quality education in Diocesan schools and colleges but received no reply.
- This incident is a wake-up call for the Archdiocesan Board of

Education to learn from Jesuits and Salesians.

- In this incident, a press reporter known to MGP for 10+ years contacted us as the original report seemed one-sided, hence the need for the school's viewpoint.
- The MGP team referred 2 clergymen in the know of the incident who, in turn, redirected to Fr. Nigel Barrett to ensure a balanced news report.
- Mobai Gaonthan Panchayat has been coordinating and following up on East Indian Community issues with the Archbishop of Bombay for 15+ years with little or no success.
- The issues raised concern Housing, Representation, Language, Culture, Tradition, Heritage, History, Existence, and Identity.
- In this case, when the Church needed support, we even contacted the clergy and gave timely reference to ensure a timely response from our Diocesan spokesperson.

While we, in MGP, representing the Indigenous People of Mumbai, East Indian Community, feel sad, hurt, pained, neglected, and rejected many times, we will do our best to stand by the Church in their times of need. We face these disappointing experiences across the Diocesan, Deanery, and Parish levels.

MGP has great faith and hope in God and His Church, irrespective of how we are treated by the clergy heads at the Parish, Diocesan, State, and National levels.

MGP's EISA Policy clearly mentions that Church property should not be sold but instead used for the benefit of the East Indian Community

- * The Indigenous People of Mumbai, East Indian Community have donated large tracts of lands to the Archdiocese
- * We have received indications of "sale of lands by the Archdiocese of Bombay" recently a notice for sale of St. Stephen's Church, Cumballa Hill was reported
- * We demand the immediate scrapping of this notice & we at Mobai Gaonthan Panchayat demand an unconditional apology from those involved and action against those who initiated this "sale of land" advertisement.
- * A sizable population of the East Indian Community have housing issues and the Diocese has not heeded our requests for the same.
- * Some East Indian families are even living on rent or in matchbox houses and it's time Archdiocese looks into this, like it was done decades ago for migrants from Goa and Mangalore.
- * All vacant unused land and redevelopment Projects should compulsorily be used for housing the East Indian Community

MGP has sent a reminder to the Archdiocese on the implementation of the EISA policy.

KASHE CHA SANN

Feast of St. Jerome's Church @ Kashimira Village

1. St.Jerome's Church stands on a hill between these two Gaothans, Kashi(Cassi) and Mira (Mirem)
- 2.The present Church is the third structures, built on the same site, blessed and opened for public worship on 26th December 1926 which continues to be celebrated as the feast day though the actual feast of St. Jerome falls in September.
- 3.The Portuguese Franciscan Fathers selected this site at Kashimira between two villages and built their first Church in the year 1595, a beautiful wooden structure made by the local carpenters and this Church lasted for 23 years, destroyed in a terrible cyclone in October 1618.
4. The second Church structure was built 1628 besides the ruins of the old Church. By 1630, the parish consisted of Gaothans – Kashi, Mira, Sanbojapal, Chene, Bandonli, Baroli and Tantoli. This church was destroyed in 1739 during the Maratha invasion.
5. The statue of St. Jerome was preserved and placed on the main altar of the 3rd Church Structure that was built 187 years later in the year 1926.
- 6.In front of the old ruined church is a cross about 386 years old and in 1926 a new cross was erected in front of the New Church.
7. On the feast day, a fair is held and is attended by thousands from all over Salsette, Bassein and Thane districts selling local farm produce,Sukelis(dry Bananas) and Ghumats
- 8.Irrespective of caste, creed and religion, people of all faith seek blessings at this church which has historic relevance. Several years ago a severe epidemic of plague gripped the region, people from all religion sought refuge in the church seeking divine intervention and were saved
9. Well decorated East Indian Reklas, Tongas and Gaaras are a common sight at the Kashimira feast
- 10.This feast is one great way of celebrating an extended Christmas Celebration with the Erangal Feast/Baravi Cha Sann just about 2 weeks away.

BARAI CHA SANN – SAN BOITUR CHA SANN - ERGAL CHA SANN

Feast of the Church of St.Bonaventure, Erangal

The original inhabitants of Bombay, the East Indian Community have been visiting Erangal for centuries popularly known by the community as, "Ergal cha Sann" or "Baravi Cha Sann". St.Bonaventure Church is an historic Church . This Annual Feast is celebrated on the 2nd Sunday of January. Many of the families who visit still follow the tradition of settling down at a nearby wadi(open place) to cook and eat together as a family.

The heritage Church at Erangal was built in the year 1575 by the Portuguese and destroyed by the Marathas in 1739. This Church was left in ruins and roofless until the 1950s. Repairs and renovations with donations from well-wishers were carried out including a roof and a new Altar. The Parish Priest of Our Lady of the Sea, Madh Island takes care of this Church.

The wide seashore in front of the Erangal church is transformed into a huge mela or fair with entertainment like giant wheel, merry-go-rounds, game stalls, horse rides and a variety of stalls selling local produce and food specialties. All the wadis from Madh to Erangal are occupied by pilgrims and their families who come by bus or their private vehicles that have replaced the traditional bullock carts. Some horse drawn 'Reklas' continue to visits the Annual fest. The air is filled with the aroma of East Indian curries cooked by pilgrims for their afternoon meals on makeshift 'chulas'. The Festival celebrations are in full swing with sound of music and dancing everywhere with the accompaniment of the Ghumat, a Traditional East Indian musical instrument. At this annual mela there are many East Indian speciality foods, musical instruments and music CD's up on sale.

There were other families around and quick neighborly are planned to meet relatives from other villages. These Church feasts also provided eligible bachelors and spinsters an opportunity for proposals and friendships, many of which ended up in marriage. Families gathered together in celebrate with music and dance accompanied with a Ghumat. Khimad, the official community drink is served followed by a traditional East Indian Lunch. The families then pack their belonging to return home but before this they have their rounds at the stalls to buy shingaras, kasras, tallas(shoots of tadgola) and the famous Ghumat!

Killa Cha Sann - St Gonsalo Garcia Church Feast- Vasai Fort Bhartiya Maha Sant

*Killa Cha Sann is celebrated on the 1st or 2nd Sunday of January at the St Gonsalo Garcia Church (formerly Church of Holy Name) at Vasai Fort



*This is the Indigenous and Annual Village Festival dedicated to Native Saint – St.Gonsalo Garcia

*The custom of a celebration of this feast in Bassein Fort was started by Rev. Fr. Peter Fernandez

*It was in and around this church that the Saint had spent his childhood and learned in the college which is attached to the church

*Father Stephan Thomas who has written the Krista Puran in Marathi also stayed here for a while

*The foundation of the St. Sabestine Citadel in Vasai Fort was done in the fort in the Month of January as well in the 16th century.

MGP will be sending a communication to the authorities for Restoration of the Church and the Vasai Fort besides requesting for a Museum and a Memorial dedicated to Maharashtra's Native Saint & India's Patron Saint.




