Gaothan residents are urging civic poll candidates to commit to a 10-point action plan, focusing on housing benefits, tax exemptions, cultural promotion, and infrastructure development in gaothans. The plan, part of the Mumbai Bhumi Putra Policy 2026, aims to protect the rights of East Indians and other original inhabitants.

The key demands include:

- HOUSING BENEFITS: Special quota in Mhada projects and a Bhumi Putra Housing Scheme

- TAX EXEMPTIONS: Pre-1960 houses in gaothans exempted from taxes

- CULTURAL PROMOTION: Preservation of heritage homes and promotion of arts, crafts, and culinary items

- INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT: Improved lighting, lanes, and street furniture without altering road widths

- SELF-GOVERNANCE: Reservation in jobs and business opportunities'

The Mobai Gaothan Panchayat (MGP) will support candidates who commit to this action plan, regardless of their political affiliation. The BMC elections are scheduled for January 15, 2026.

Devouts celebrate Kashi-Mira Cha Sann in age-old style

Keeping the centuries-old traditions alive, devouts from far-off places ride on bullock carts to reach St Jerome's church in the Kashimira village on Friday, marking the 90th anniversary of the third religious structure built in 1926. It was constructed after the first two churches, one dating back to 1895, were destroyed. 'Kashi-Mira Cha Sann', the anniversary of the third shrine, is annually celebrated a day after Christmas, with a feast and fair, which draws thousands.

Following in the steps of



their ancestors from hundreds of years ago, families from villages as far away as Manori, located across the Marve creek off Malad, began their journey on bullock carts on Thursday evening. After arriving at the church at night, they set up encampments with makeshift kitchens and prepared traditional East Indian dishes such

as chicken mollee, accompanied by traditional alcoholic drink khimad.

Mario Gracias, a resident of Khareli, Malad, came with his in-laws who are from Manori. Gracias said that in the past, farmers and toddy tappers from Dharavi, Beth, the local name of the island that includes the coast from Manori to Uttan, travelled in carts. "We are preserving that tradition. It is a time for prayers and also to enjoy food and dance," said Gracias.

There were joyful scenes as the locals sold delicacies such as sukidi or banana and traditional East Indian musical instruments like ghumats.

The church stands on a hill between the gaothans Kashi and Mira. Portuguese Franciscan priests built their first edifice here in 1895.

According to local history, the beautiful wooden structure stood for 23 years till it was destroyed in a 1618 cyclone. The second church, built in 1828, was destroyed in 1739 during the Maratha attack.

Bosco Patel, coordinator for Mobai Gaothan Panchayat, said, "Irrespective of caste, creed and religion, many seek blessings at this church. Years ago, plague gripped the region, people from all religions sought refuge in the church."

Top 5 points about the 430-year-old Mumbai Bhumi Putra East Indian Village festival:

1. FEAST OF ST. JEROME'S CHURCH: Celebrated on Dec 26, the day after Christmas, in Kashimira Village.

2. HISTORIC CHURCH: 3rd structure built in 1926 on the same site as the 1595 original Church.

3. UNITY IN DIVERSITY: People of all faiths attend, seeking blessings & selling local produce, Sukelis, Ghumats.

4. DECORATED REKLAS & TONGAS: A common sight at the Kashimira feast, celebrating East Indian culture.

5. EXTENDED CHRISTMAS CHEER: Follows Christmas, precedes Erangal Feast/Baravi Cha Sann.

EISA POLICY

Rights of the Indigenous People in the Archdiocese



EAST INDIAN SAMAJ ARCHDIOCESE POLICY

CULTURE PROMOTION

- *East Indian Bhavan lands to be allotted at Goregaon Seminary site
- *Churches to ensure full support to all East Indian Community religious traditions
- *Agera, the East Indian Harvest Festival should be given support and to be termed as the official festival of the Archdiocese
- *All East Indian groups should be given church premises for free to promote their culture and tradition

CASTE CERTIFICATE

- *Simplified OBC certificate process for East Indian Community by approvals at deanery level
- *In Church records, new births to mention caste as East Indian in their Baptism certificate
- *In School records, new admissions to mention caste as East Indian in their School records which will reflect in the Leaving certificate

HOUSING

- *Additional flats in Housing Reconstruction projects by Church on existing societies should be allotted only to East Indians
- *A special Bhumi Putra Housing Scheme to be initiated for East Indian Samaj on Church vacant lands
- *All beneficiaries of church owned flats now settled abroad to return the same for East Indian Community

GAOTHANS AND PROTECTION

- *Church should ensure the protection of the Gaothans as the Gaothan residents were the founders and donors for the local church
- *Gaothan Holy Crosse should be recognised and supported for their restoration
- *A Special Gaothan Emergency Fund to be initiated to assist needy families for their house repairs

RELIGIOUS TRADITIONS

- *East Indian Lenten Traditions like papiya, processions and Krist Puran should be supported in all parishes
- *Special Marian Holidays to be given to schools for the Velankanni pilgrimage
- *Church to maintain data of all Chapels and Holy Crosses and ensure their upkeep and protection

LANDS AND PROPERTIES

- *Properties donated should not be sold
- *Church to return donated lands to original owners if they can't maintain

MEDICAL SUPPORT

- *A special medical fund to support needy families with simplified process
- *Special discounts on hospitalisation bills to all East Indians in Catholic hospitals
- *Special discounts on medical check-ups to all East Indians in Catholic hospitals
- *Group Medilaim policy to be initiated to cover all East Indians by the diocese

COMPENSATION TOWARDS DONATED PROPERTY

- *In lieu of Church donated lands sold or rented commercially, 10% proceeds to be transferred to East Indian Community Fund
- *Party venues on Church property should be given at special discounts for the East Indian Community
- *Special discounts on medical bills at all Catholic hospitals

FUND GENERATION

- *All income from hired property for sports and party venues should have 10% of the proceeds allocated towards East Indian Community welfare
- *All collections should have 5% allotted towards the medical needs of the East Indian Community

BUSINESS

- *East Indian Food stalls to be approved for each parish
- *The school and college canteens to be allotted to the East Indian Community
- *All church projects should be allotted only to the East Indians
- *Each Church festival should allot a section of prominent stalls to East Indians
- *Space to be allotted in church premises for East Indian businesses
- *East Indian Baazaar to be permitted at all Churches to promote East Indian Cuisine and handicrafts
- *Monopoly or panel for Church venues to be given only to the East Indians

EAST INDIAN SAMAJ ARCHDIOCESE POLICY

JOBS

- *Special job reservations for East Indian community in all catholic schools, colleges, Churches, hospitals and other facilities
- *Skilling centres to be set up at all parishes to train and skill community members

REPRESENTATION

- *East Indian Representatives to be appointed with Special representation in the Archdiocese of Bombay
- *East Indian Representative must be appointed by the local East Indian group in the Parish council
- *Church property and finance committee should only have representatives from the East Indian Community
- *Bishops and Dean's should be appointed only from the East Indian community
- *Local community association heads to be authorised to suggest Church projects and initiatives
- *Venues and facilities on church owned property to be dedicated to Cardinal Simon Pimenta in every deanery of Bombay Diocese

TOURISM

- *A special religious tour with guides from the East Indian Community to be initiated with visits to heritage churches and native devotions

LANGUAGE AND DIALECT

- *To promote the East Indian Dialect, holy masses should be organised every week at East Indian founded or dominated parishes
- *All special holy masses on days of obligation should only be in English, Marathi and East Indian
- *Masses at prominent time slots should only be in English, Marathi and East Indian
- *At all Church festivals the feast mass should be in East Indian Marathi

COMMUNITY WELFARE

- *An East Indian Community welfare fund to be instituted through funds allocated from land income on East Indian donated lands
- *Monthly Open Meetings by Bishops with the East Indian Community to discuss community welfare initiatives and issues faced

HISTORY AND HERITAGE

- *East Indians Day to be observed and recognised by the Archdiocese
- *All Churches should mention History of the Church with the East Indian connect and a signage mentioning that the Church land is donated by the East Indian Community
- *All Churches should be restored and revived but not renovated or rebuilt to promote heritage
- *Heritage Churches should be given special status and the one which were rebuilt should be given their original facade

NATIVE DEVOTIONS

- *St.Gonsalo Garcia Day to be officially recognised by the Archdiocese
- *St.Gonsalo Garcia Church to be opened in Bombay Diocese
- *St.Gonsalo Garcia should be considered as the Principal Patron saint of the Bombay Diocese
- *Mount Mary Church devotion to be promoted across churches
- *Mount Mary Church Octave feast should have representation and support only by the festival founders, East Indian Community
- *The Bandra fair at the Mount should have specially allotted stalls for the Indigenous East Indian Community

EDUCATION

- *Preference for East Indian teachers from the Village and it's vicinity
- *Free Education in all our schools and colleges for East Indians
- *All additional fees towards co-curricular, sports & stationery to be supported through a Special Education fund

The Rights of the Indigenous People



HOUSING

- * Housing Quota on MHADA projects for East Indians
- * A special Bhumi Putra Housing Scheme to be initiated
- * Gaothan expansion policy to be implemented by allotting lands towards East Indian community housing projects in lieu of land unavailable around gaothans

INFRA COMPENSATION

The community lands were taken away under various laws like Land Acquisition Act, Land to tiller Act, Urban Land Ceiling Act and the original owners were never compensated . These lands which were taken for infra projects are now today converted to commercial projects hence a compensation for these need to be given especially for the below mentioned projects which are on lands with East Indians as original owners

- * Sahar International Airport and Santacruz Domestic Airport
- * Bandra Kurla Complex
- * Kalina University
- * Aarey
- * Railways
- * Juhu Aerodrome

TAX

The East Indians as Indigenous People should not be taxed

- * No Municipal Property and Water Tax for all houses in the Gaothans owned before 1960
- * Electricity with a special scheme basis consumption where those upto a specific consumption get it for free

CULTURE PROMOTION

- * East Indian Bhavan in Mumbai-Thane-Vasai and Raigad
- * Special permissions for time limit to be given for Umbrachapani and Christmas midnight mass

Bhumiputra representation is a must to protect the identity of East Indians. The Parish Council, Committees and the Archdiocesan College of Consultors should be led and represented by the East Indians. It's Municipal Elections time and it's great to see a slight increase in candidates contesting from the Indigenous People communities. Decades ago when the British had village based municipalities, almost all the Vice Presidents were Indigenous People of Mumbai. After the formation of a common city based municipality, the representation of Indigenous People decreased gradually and is today at an all time low. MGP in its press release is very clear that 5 nominated corporators as well as the Mayor should be a Bhumi Putra from Mumbai. An alternate plan is being worked on to announce a Bhumi Putra mayor-like head to promote and protect Mumbai's History, Heritage, Existence & Identity.

It's high time people and leaders around us stop taking us for granted, especially migrants. East Indians have faced enough of injustice and it's time to speak up.

Mumbai founders have the first right on its future and no individuals or group can snatch away this right from us. East Indians were known to be welcoming and hospitable but we should not be taken for granted. We will demand what is rightfully ours as Indigenous People of Mumbai. Mumbai is our native place and we will reside here till our last breath unlike migrants who will run away to their native place in times of emergency. MGP will continue with its mission to promote East Indian Community as the Indigenous People of Mumbai. A special reference name for the East Indian Community is also being planned this year. Signages across parishes mentioning East Indians land donors and founders of local historic churches will be pressed for across the Archdiocese of Bombay and Vasai.

Indigenous People rights has to be granted by the authorities - Political, Government and Archdiocese. Mumbai Bhumi Putra Policy & East Indian Samaj Archdiocese - EISA Policy edition for the year 2026 has been released and will be presented to the leadership in the coming weeks. 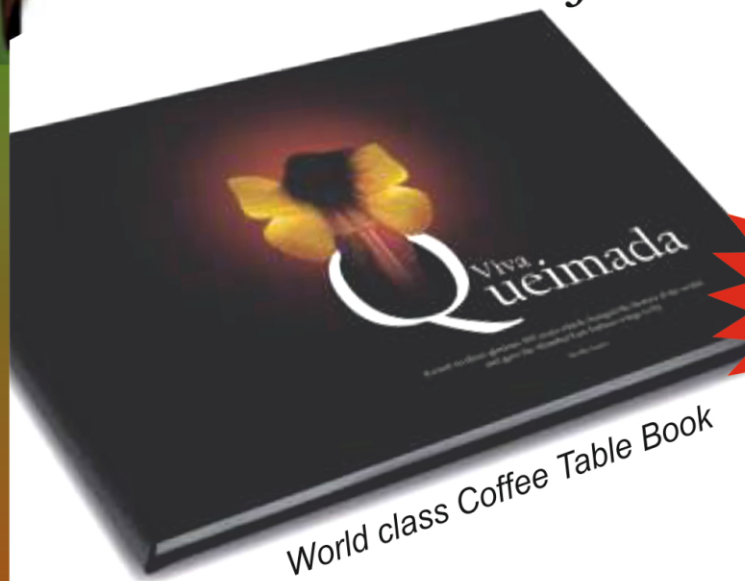

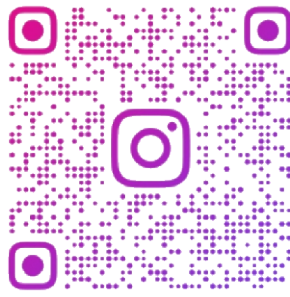
